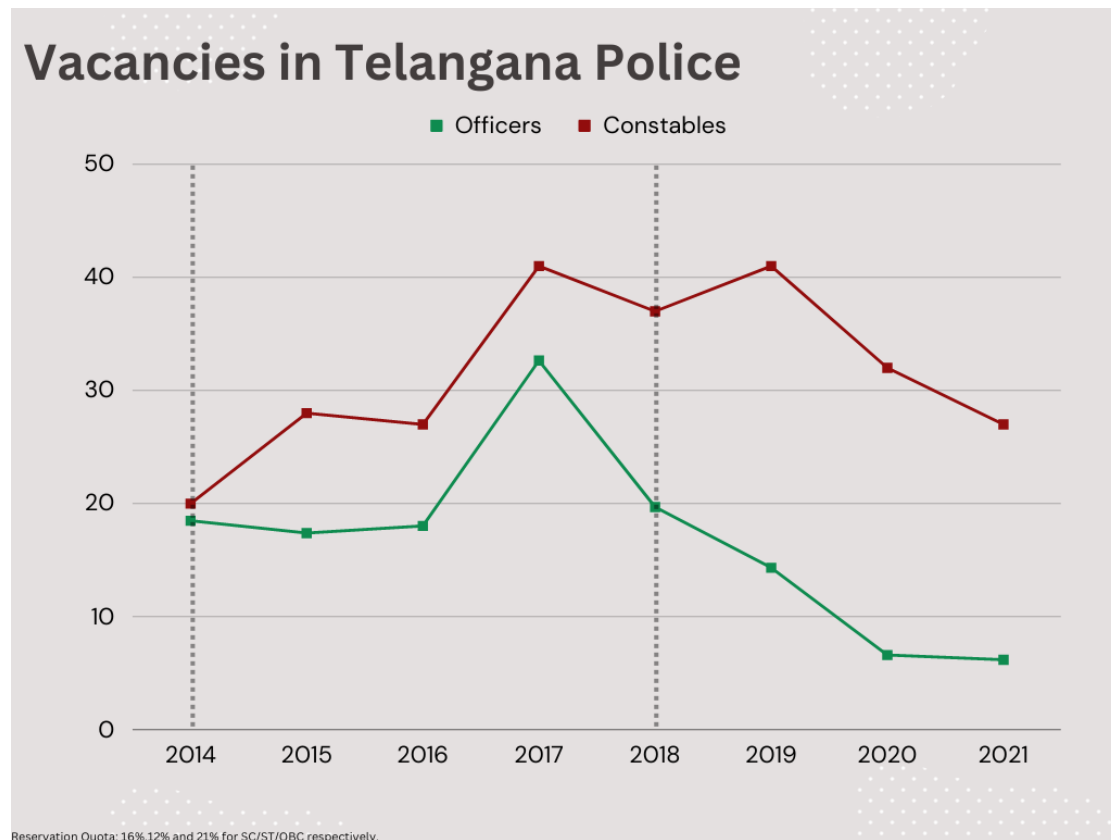

Share of women among subordinate courts and High court judges of Telangana.

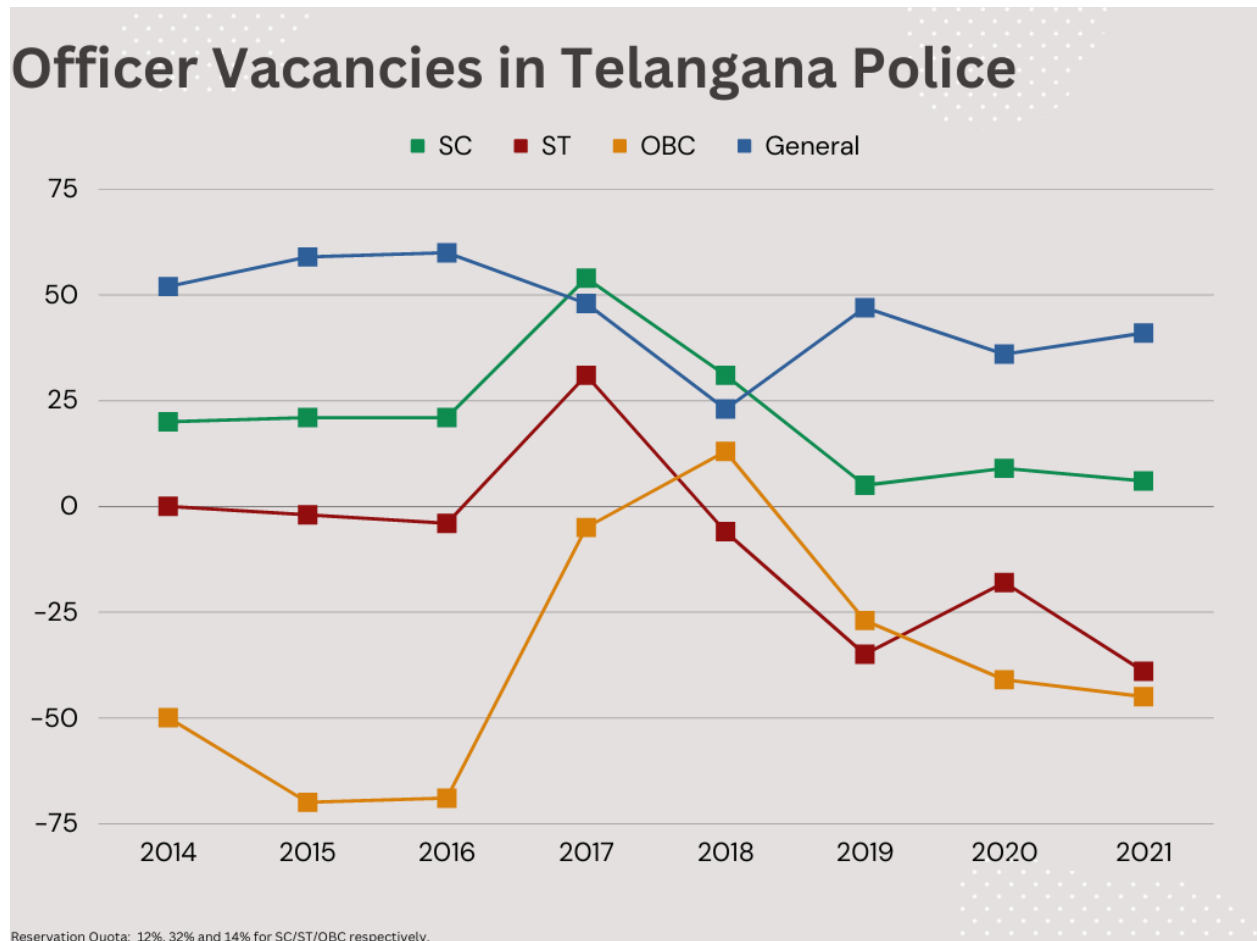

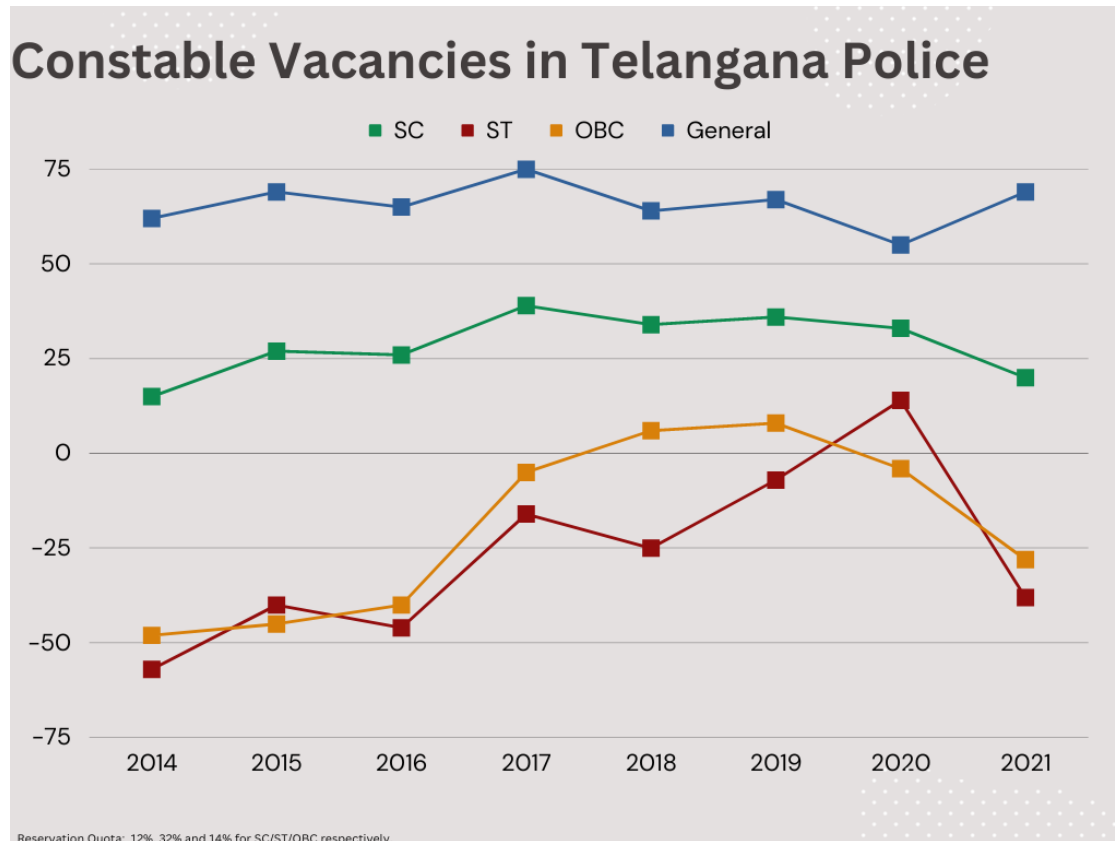

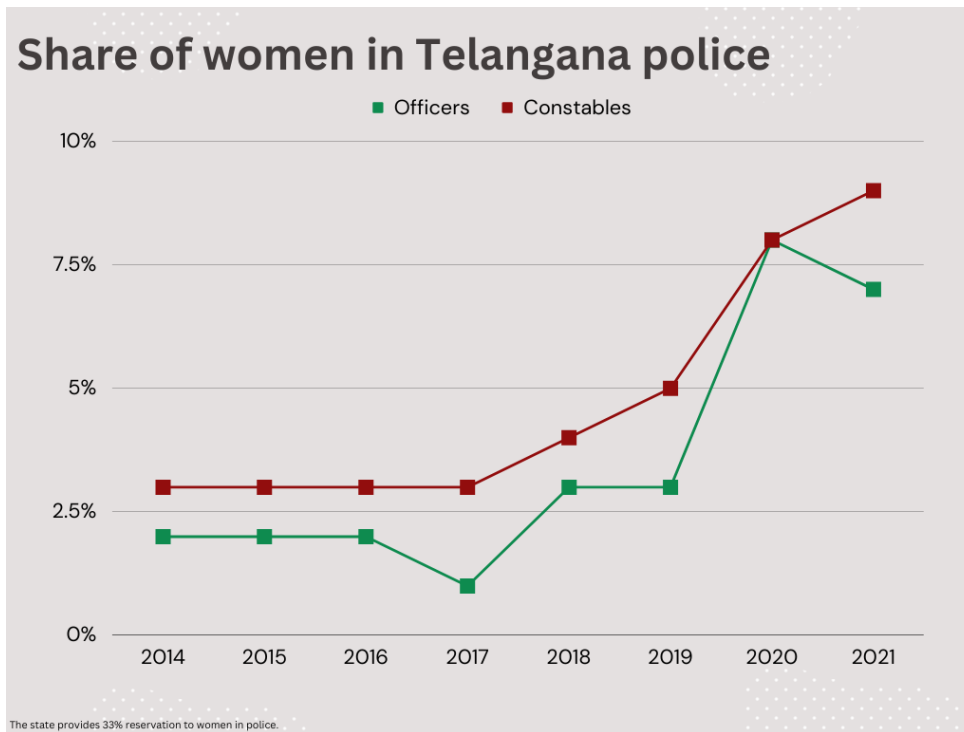
